Parking Automation Update

Over the course of the late fall and winter, McMaster's parking automation plan has been implemented. All main campus lots, with the exception of Lot H on the north side of campus, have been equipped with automated entry and exit gates. These gates are in operation 24 hours a day, seven days a week. In the coming weeks, the automated entry and exit gates in Lot H will be activated. This includes an exit-only gate at Forsyth Avenue North. Once operational, vehicles parking in Lot H will be able to exit campus via the Forsyth Avenue North gate. Vehicles entering campus will continue to use the Sterling Avenue entry gate or the entry at Main Street.

McMaster Special Duty Police Officers

Special duty Hamilton police officers continue to patrol the neighbourhoods surrounding the campus. The officers are funded by the University and the McMaster Students Union. McMaster supports the Police and City's zero tolerance approach to noise and other infractions. Pan-Am Games Bid

The City of Toronto is organizing a bid to host the 2015 Pan American Games. The bid includes cities across the Golden Horseshoe including Hamilton. McMaster is currently in the Pan-Am bid to be the site of a new 50-metre swimming pool, which would replace the existing campus pool. McMaster's current swimming pool is forty-years old and won't be useable in the long-term unless it undergoes significant restoration work. The current pool is heavily used by student clubs and teams, faculty and staff at McMaster and McMaster's summer camps. The Pan Am Games committee will select a host city later this year.
