Summer Camp Traffic Plan

Monday, June 30, kicks off McMaster's popular Summer Camp programs. Each year thousands of local children rely on these camp activities for summer fun and enjoyment, while benefitting from physical and educational development.

As in past years, traffic management plans to safely accommodate campers and their parents have been reviewed and updated. This process included a meeting in May with leaders of the Mayfair Oval Property Association who have had input into this plan. This year, the parking and traffic plan includes:

- Clearer directions and instructions issued to parents as they prepare to drop off and pick up their children at camp, including reminders to enter via Sterling Street and not to stop or park on Mayfair or Forsyth
- Routing all school buses to locations on campus to drop off and pick up children, thus avoiding buses being parked on Forsyth North. Buses will enter campus via the Main Street West entrance
- Positioning of parking attendants at key points, including at the junction of Forsyth North and Mayfair to direct traffic to enter campus via Sterling Street
- Improved signage directing camp traffic to appropriate entry and exit points

A reminder that summer camps operate in two-week cycles. Experience has shown that it may take a few days at the beginning of each cycle for parents to familiarize themselves with the parking and traffic routing. As always, your patience is greatly appreciated as we work to ensure a successful and safe camp season for all stakeholders.

For your information, a copy of the key parking and transportation instructions and the map distributed to parents is attached.
