Established in 1986, the MSUAA provides a forum for communication amongst former student leaders, support projects that benefit student life, and to draw on former leaders' experience in support of the contemporary Students Union. Over 2,000 alumni are on our database, including those who were involved as undergraduates through the Student Representative Assembly (SRA), the MSU executive, as an MSU part-time manager, or in University governance as a student representative on the Board of Governors or Senate.

Activities

The MSUAA sponsors an annual alumni award, organizes reunions, undertakes research on student leadership history at McMaster, and responds to frequent requests for information and advice from contemporary student leaders.

Since 1987, the MSUAA's annual Lifetime Achievement Award for Leadership has recognized alumni who demonstrated leadership first as students, and again in the greater community following graduation. The recipient delivers keynote remarks at Student Recognition Night, the MSU's annual dinner recognizing student leaders.

Other highlights include:

2004: Inauguration of web pages as a component of the MSU web site and the SRA 40th anniversary reunion.

2005: The Silhouette 75th Anniversary Reunion and presentation of a plaque, bearing the names of all former executive editors, to recognize leadership in student journalism.

2007: The McMaster Honour Society 75th Anniversary Reunion.

2010: The Silhouette 80th Anniversary Reunion.
